

UDFSC CLUB ICE INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

1. Club Ice will be canceled when the rink is closed or when there is a late opening of UD Facilities due to weather. This policy will be in place in the event where there is inclement weather, but the rink is NOT closed.
2. The safety of the Club Ice Monitor and the skaters is the primary concern. It is understood that UDFSC will likely end up paying for the session if we cancel it at the last minute. If the UD rink is open but the assigned monitor is unable to drive or get to the rink in the bad weather, then the Club Ice Liaison needs to decide to find a substitute or to cancel the sessions.
3. With an inclement weather forecast, the UDFSC Club Ice Liaison should contact the Monitor the day before Club ice sessions to determine their ability to monitor Club Ice. Other monitors on the list should be contacted for their availability to cover these sessions.
4. In case a monitor is not found, Club ice will be canceled, and no skaters will be permitted to skate during the normal club ice session times, unless the rink makes the decision to re-purpose the ice and provide their own monitor.
5. In the case where the weather does not arrive until the overnight hours or in the case where the actual weather is worse than what was forecasted, the following process will be followed:
 - By 7:00 am Sunday morning Club Ice Liaison will contact Club Ice Monitor via phone to determine a path forward.
 - If the Club Ice Liaison anticipates being away during a weekend when there is Club Ice scheduled, another Board member will be designated to be responsible for contacting the Ice Monitor should there be bad weather.
6. Once a decision to cancel has been made, the Club Ice Liaison will be responsible for contacting the rink to let them know the club ice session will be cancelled. They also must make the rink staff aware that we will not be responsible for any skaters on the ice during our reserved club ice time. If the rink wishes to repurpose the ice to a training center session and provide a monitor that is their decision.
7. The Club Ice Liaison will send an email to Membership stating that Club Ice is canceled due to inclement weather and will ask Social Media Chair to post on Facebook and Instagram.
8. If a list of emails of Non-Members who have skated on Club Ice is available, they will also receive the same email as members.
9. The Club Ice Monitor may reach out at any time to the Club Ice Liaison to initiate a cancelation or request a substitute as they deem necessary.
10. A copy of this policy and a current copy of Board Member contacts and UD Ice Arenas Rink contacts will be provided to all authorized Club Ice Monitors.
